## **2. Graduate profile and educational goals**

The fields of study Law and International Law encompass theoretical knowledge and practical skills in the understanding and application of law. Law constitutes an interconnected, internally structured system of generally binding norms governing the functioning of human society in accordance with the principles of democracy and the rule of law. The study of the study programme is carried out from the perspective of a comparative view of national legal systems, their historical-legal context and traditions, and to a significant extent from the perspective of European Union law and international law. It is based on the values of democracy, the rule of law, respect for the individual, the protection of fundamental rights and freedoms, as well as the principles of honest legal professional and scientific activity.

- on the basis of acquired knowledge of the theory of law, sociology of law, legal history with an emphasis on the Roman law tradition, and other subjects dealing with historical as well as contemporary concepts of the rule of law, acquires knowledge of the principles of the organisation and functioning of the state, as well as the ability to apply methods and forms of activity in public administration from the perspective of law-making and application of law,
- possesses basic knowledge of the institutions of public and private law, in particular from a comparative perspective,

The study plan of the study programme was prepared in accordance with the Agreement on the Terms and Conditions of Cooperation in the Implementation of a Joint Higher Education Study Programme concluded between UŽNU and Comenius University in Bratislava, as well as with the internal regulations of the cooperating faculties.

The study plan determines the temporal and content sequence of courses, the assigned educational activities (lectures, tutorials, seminars, consultations, etc.), and the forms of assessment of study results. Each course is completed by an appropriate form of assessment depending on the nature of the course. - a) List and characteristics of study program classrooms and their technical equipment with assignment to educational outcomes and subject (laboratories, project and art studios, studios, workshops, translator’s booths, clinics, priestly seminars, science and technology parks, technology incubators, educational establishments, practice centers, training schools, teaching and training facilities, sports halls, swimming pools, sports grounds).

**For PraF UK:**

Information and communication technologies constitute an important element in administrative, pedagogical, as well as scientific and research processes; therefore, ensuring their efficient operation and functioning is an essential component within the strategic planning of the faculty’s financial resources.

As regards the provision of PraF UK in Bratislava with computing equipment, the faculty currently has at its disposal 252 personal computers (PC/AiO), 157 laptops, 31 tablets, 39 projectors, 123 printers (including multifunction devices), 6 larger copying machines and 11 standalone scanning devices (scanners).

Teaching at PraF UK is currently carried out in 21 classrooms of varying capacity, ranging from 20 to 193 seats. These include: 4 SB – 83 seats, 5 SB – 37 seats, 6 SB – 24 seats, 10a SB – 24 seats, 10b SB – 20 seats, 12 SB – 38 seats, 209 SB – 15 seats, 223 SB – 38 seats, 309 SB – 15 seats, 411 SB – 34 seats, 1 NB – 52 seats, 518 NB – 56 seats, 519 NB – 25 seats, 601 NB – 68 seats, 604 NB – 68 seats, 618 NB – 42 seats, 619 NB – 24 seats, Courtroom – 69 seats, Auditorium Maximum – 193 seats, Iuridicum – 26 seats, Dean’s Club – 27 seats.

Of the above-mentioned teaching rooms, 11 classrooms (i.e. more than half) have already undergone complete reconstruction. At the same time, each room is equipped with a computer or laptop with internet access and connection to a projector with screen projection. One of the reconstructed classrooms may be fully used as a computer room, not only for teaching but also for organising various trainings or seminars requiring the use of modern multimedia equipment.

As part of the continuous improvement and enhancement of the teaching process, the gradual reconstruction of the remaining classrooms, as well as their equipment with modern technical devices (computer, projector, screen, sound system), is planned in the near future.

At the same time, PraF UK has acquired a building at Vajanského nábrežie 10, which, after reconstruction, will include 7 classrooms, 1 lecture hall, 2 multifunctional rooms, 25 offices, 3 meeting rooms, 3 archive rooms, 8 storage spaces, 3 technical rooms, 1 boiler room, 1 apartment, a courtyard, restaurant premises and several sanitary facilities and kitchenettes on each floor. Reconstruction is planned for the coming years, with progress evaluated in the faculty's annual reports.

It should also be noted that students and staff of PraF UK have access to modern sports facilities, including a sports hall, movement studio, gym, as well as associated changing rooms and showers, located in the basement of the New Building of PraF UK in Bratislava, all of which underwent complete reconstruction between 2017 and 2019. The Institute of Physical Education, as a specialised unit of PraF UK, ensures the pedagogical process in these premises and oversees them. From the technical perspective of ensuring the study programme, it should be noted that each faculty employee is provided with access to a computer and to all network services (internet, e-mail, Nové ASPI, [www.iudikaty.info](http://www.iudikaty.info) / [zakony.iudikaty.info](http://zakony.iudikaty.info), Beck-online, AIS 2, selected staff SAP). Since 2020, there has been a gradual transition to the newer Windows 10 operating system and a phase-out of the LTSB distribution. Currently, all work/service computers and laptops operate on Windows 10, with a few exceptions (for IT department purposes). Faculty staff also use the Office 2016 suite, which is gradually being replaced by the latest Office 365 version. Financial resources are regularly allocated for the purchase of licences for new computers and for updates of the ESET antivirus system.

PraF UK is connected to the university network and the internet via a node at the Rectorate of Comenius University. The backbone of the local network is physically divided into three locations due to the layout of the faculty premises, interconnected by optical cables with a switch at the Rectorate, together forming the network backbone of the Faculty of Law. Wi-Fi signal (wireless rectorate network Eduroam) currently covers almost all classrooms and the library, as well as most offices. In some offices and classrooms, the faculty Wi-Fi network FLAW Student is used. All desktop computers are connected to the rectorate network within the PraF UK subnet with a connection speed of at least 100 Mb/s via ethernet technology.

Electronic mail (MS Outlook 2016 / Outlook 365) is used for internal and external communication, with each academic and administrative employee (including external staff) automatically assigned an individual e-mail account on the Office 365 platform (university e-mail account). Students, including internal and external doctoral students, are also provided with a university e-mail account.

The comprehensive agenda and needs of the study department are covered by the AIS 2 information system, the implementation of which in 2010 resulted in a reduction of administrative workload and facilitated access to information, not only for teaching staff but especially for students, as it enables easier and more transparent management of study obligations, including from outside faculty premises. In 2019, a new visual build AIS 2 version 2.5.402.59 was introduced.

The overall operation of computer equipment, multimedia technology for teaching purposes, as well as the entire faculty network, servers and e-mail system is ensured by the Information Technology Department, which, in cooperation with the Support Services Unit, also provides procurement and, where necessary, warranty and post-warranty servicing.

#### **For PraF UŽNU:**

Information and communication technologies constitute a key element of the educational and scientific research process at the Faculty of Law of UŽNU, particularly in the study of International Law, which requires continuous access to international databases and foreign-language resources. The efficient functioning of the IT infrastructure is therefore a priority of the faculty's strategic planning.

#### **Technical equipment:**

At present, the Faculty of Law of UŽNU has at its disposal more than 180 personal computers and laptops for the needs of teaching and administrative staff. The faculty is equipped with modern multimedia devices, including 25 stationary projectors, interactive whiteboards and portable presentation systems. Specialised computer classrooms with access to high-speed internet are available for students of international law.

#### **Classrooms and premises:**

Teaching is conducted in two main buildings (Kapitulna 26 and the university campus at Univerzitetstva 14). The faculty has a total of 18 classrooms of varying capacity (from 15 to 120 seats) and 4 large lecture halls (auditoria) with a capacity of over 150 seats. Specific premises for practical teaching include:

- **Courtroom (Moot Court):** intended for simulated court proceedings, which are essential for students of international law.

- **Centre of International Law:** a specialised room equipped with terminals providing access to legal libraries of the UN, the Council of Europe and the EU.
- **Computer laboratories:** 2 rooms fully equipped for teaching subjects requiring the use of legal information systems.
- **Conference hall:** equipped with videoconferencing technology and facilities for hybrid teaching, enabling online lectures by experts from partner universities abroad (including Comenius University in Bratislava).

More than 60% of classrooms have undergone reconstruction in recent years and are equipped with Wi-Fi connection and presentation technology. Within the framework of the “Smart University” development, the faculty plans the gradual digitalisation of the remaining premises.

#### **Sports and recreational facilities:**

Students have access to extensive sports infrastructure of UŽNU, including:

- the “Burevisnyk” sports complex (sports halls, swimming pool, outdoor sports facilities),
- specialised gyms located near the faculty. These facilities are used for the Physical Education course and for students’ leisure activities under the supervision of the Department of Physical Education.

#### **Information systems and software:**

Each lecturer and student is assigned a university e-mail account and access to the Google Workspace for Education platform. Since 2021, there has been an intensive transition to cloud-based solutions and the use of the Moodle e-learning system, where study materials for all international law courses are digitised. Staff use Windows 10/11 operating systems and the MS Office 365 suite. For legal research, licences of systems such as Liga:Zakon and access to international open databases (e.g. HUDOC, UNTC) are available.

#### **Network infrastructure:**

Faculty buildings are interconnected with the central UŽNU node via optical cables. Nearly 90% of faculty premises are covered by Wi-Fi (UzhNU-Free and secured staff networks).

#### **Administration and maintenance:**

The operation of equipment and networks is ensured by the UŽNU Information Technology Centre in cooperation with the faculty’s technical staff. They provide servicing, licence procurement (including antivirus protection) and technical support for hybrid teaching.

- b) Characteristics of the information documents on the study program (access to study literature according to subject information sheets), access to information databases and other information sources, information technologies, etc.).

Firstly, it is necessary to state that access to the study literature, necessary for mastering the subjects included in the study program in question, will primarily be provided by the Library of Faculty of Law of the Comenius University in Bratislava.

The Library of Faculty of Law of the Comenius University in Bratislava has been creating an information background for teaching and scientific activities at the faculty since 1991. In the years 1979-1991 it was part of the Central Library and the study and information center of social science departments of Comenius University. The library of Faculty of Law of the Comenius University in Bratislava fulfills the following functions and tasks, which result from its statute:

- collects, professionally processes, preserves, protects, and grants access to domestic and foreign scientific and professional library documents,
- provides library and information services to registered users, especially teachers, researchers, students, and the public in accordance with library and lending regulations,
- preserves and bibliographically registers qualification theses defended at the faculty,
- is the workplace for bibliographic registration of the publication activity of teachers, scientific workers, and doctoral students of full-time and part-time studies at the faculty,
- participates in the creation, maintenance and providing access to library catalogs.

Its library holdings, which as of the end of 2025 consisted of 131,966 library units, are made accessible to registered users in accordance with the Library and Lending Regulations of the Academic Library of Comenius University in Bratislava and the Lending Regulations of the Library of PraF UK in Bratislava. The documents in question, as well as other relevant internal regulations concerning the operation of the Library, may be found here:

In 2025, the holdings of the Library of PraF UK were expanded by 1,719 library units, and as of 31 December 2025 amounted to 131,966 library units. In 2025, 576 books, 220 volumes of bound periodicals, 13 hard-copy final theses and 910 electronic final theses were added. During the calendar year, the library received 66 periodical titles (18 of Slovak and 48 of foreign provenance).

The library also continued to expand the database of current bibliography; 769 records of articles from selected legal journals, as well as collections published by PraF UK, were added to the library catalogue. The Library of PraF UK also participated in building the union library catalogue, which accumulates information on the holdings of individual faculty libraries, to which it contributed 1,726 library units. As of 31 December 2025, the number of automatically processed documents was 96,125.

Users of the library services, who are primarily bachelor's and master's students at PraF UK, may acquaint themselves with the library holdings through the Union Online Catalogue of Comenius University, available at the following web address: <https://alis.uniba.sk:8443/search/query?theme=Katalog>, or directly in the library reading room in the PraF UK building.

In addition to references to books and bound periodicals, the library catalogue also contains bibliographic records of articles from selected legal periodicals (Justičná revue, Právny obzor, Policajná teória a prax, Acta Facultatis Iuridicae, Časopis pro právní vědu a praxi, Jurisprudence, Právnik, Právni rozhledy, Správní právo, American Journal of Comparative Law, International and Comparative Law Quarterly, International Journal of Legal Information and Bratislava Law Review, as well as collections of papers). The library catalogue currently contains more than 18,000 bibliographic records of analytical parts of periodicals and collections.

The agenda of registration of publication activity also forms part of bibliographic and information services. From 1 February 2024, Comenius University began actively using the new PETRA system ([petra.uniba.sk](http://petra.uniba.sk); Publications-Evaluation-ResearchAgenda), which, unlike the previous EviPUB/Virtua system, is capable of working more accurately with the links between the author and the publication (reported vs. non-reported vs. unreported with regard to the duration and extent of the author's employment at Comenius University; registration of publications and citations of external applicants for the title of associate professor/professor; retrospective processing of publications of fluctuating authors, etc.).

Access to and the premises of the Library of PraF UK are arranged barrier-free, which fully enables their use also by students with special needs. Out of the total area of 857 m<sup>2</sup>, user premises account for 450 m<sup>2</sup>. Lockable lockers for visitors are located in front of the reading rooms. For the protection of the library holdings, a security electromagnetic system and a camera system have been installed. The camera system consists of 9 cameras strategically placed so as to cover the entire area of the library.

Library services are provided to users every working day, while the opening hours of the library vary depending on the schedule of the academic year. As a standard, during the semester the library is available to readers for 48 operating hours per week. The library provides lending services – off-site/on-site, while the conditions for borrowing documents are regulated by the Lending Regulations of the Library of PraF UK [https://www.flaw.uniba.sk/fileadmin/praf/Sluzby/kniznica/sluzby/VPoriadok\\_2020.pdf2.pdf](https://www.flaw.uniba.sk/fileadmin/praf/Sluzby/kniznica/sluzby/VPoriadok_2020.pdf2.pdf), as well as information and search services, electronic services and reprographic services.

- Other databases: ATLA religion database, American Psychological Association (APA), Academic Video Online, Statista.com, JSTOR, ScienceDirect, Springer Nature, UV/Vis± Photochemistry Database, Knovel, ACM Digital Library and IEEE Xplore
- Open Access sources: EZB, DOAJ, DOAB, FREE, Forum Historiae, SCOAP, OA journals Oxford University Press, OA journals Cambridge University Press, OA journals Taylor & Francis Online, Journal of Visualized Experiments

The library also implements test accesses to other electronic databases. Online consultations on literature research in electronic sources are available for users.

Computers with internet access are available to readers in the library premises, while Wi-Fi access is available throughout the library.

Another useful source of information on the activities of the Library of PraF UK is the continuously updated library website, which also contains basic information related to the operation of the library itself. It also includes links providing direct access to the Union Online Catalogue of the Academic Library of Comenius University and the database of publication activity of teachers, as well as other useful links. From the perspective of the requirement to ensure teaching by the necessary study literature, the publishing activity of PraF UK is also of importance, whereby, in accordance with the requirements of individual departments and with the Editorial Plan of PraF UK, the publication of various types of works within individual publication series is ensured. The needs of PraF UK in issuing books and teaching materials for the improvement of the pedagogical process are organisationally assisted by the Editorial and Publishing Unit of PraF UK in Bratislava. Since 2015, publications have also been issued in cooperation with Wolters Kluwer, s. r. o., within the publication series of textbooks and exercise books, commentaries, monographs and collections. In cooperation with the Publishing House of Comenius University, the journal *Acta Facultatis Iuridicae Universitatis Comenianae* has been published since 1966. The sale of older titles published by PraF UK until 2015 also continued in 2020 through a network of bookshops in Bratislava, Trnava and Banská Bystrica. Distribution and sale of publications issued in cooperation with Wolters Kluwer is provided by Wolters Kluwer.

In recent years, the Editorial and Publishing Unit has cooperated with several printing houses (e.g. GUPRESS Bratislava, Resprint Senica, Heuréka, s.r.o. Šamorín, A+M print Bratislava, KO & KA spol. s r. o., Tlačiareň K-PRINT), however, in the recent period the printing house selected under public procurement has been BELLIFER s. r. o., Krátka 160/7, 905 01 Senica.

In addition to the services offered by the Library of PraF UK, it should be added that PraF UK has long ensured for its staff and students access to important legal information systems which are essential not only in legal practice, but which it is also appropriate to become acquainted with and begin using already during legal studies. Access has been provided for students and staff to the legal information systems [judikaty.info](http://judikaty.info) and [zakony.judikaty.info](http://zakony.judikaty.info). Students and staff may use these legal information systems in the course of their studies and also during examinations with non-annotated legal regulations. Their main advantage is accessibility in any internet browser on a PC, tablet or other device. Owing to cooperation with Wolters Kluwer, s. r. o., access has also been provided for students and staff to

the online version of the legal information system noveaspi.sk. Students and staff may use it in the course of their studies and also during examinations with non-annotated legal regulations. Students and staff also have access to the legal information system BECK ONLINE, which is provided by the Rectorate of Comenius University. Access to BECK ONLINE is possible within the university network, and students and staff may use it in the course of their studies and also during examinations with non-annotated legal regulations. Students and staff have access not only to legislation and case law, but also to selected monographs of this publisher.

**For PraF UŽNU:**

Access to study literature, scholarly sources and information resources necessary for mastering the courses within the study programme in International Law is ensured primarily by the **Scientific Library of UŽNU**, together with the specialised resources of the Faculty of Law and international databases to which the university has subscribed access.

**1. Scientific Library of UŽNU**

The Scientific Library has been providing the information background for the teaching and scientific activity of the university since 1945.

**Holdings and resources:**

As of 2025/2026, the library holdings consist of more than 1.5 million library units. For the field of International Law, a strong collection of professional literature has been established, including textbooks, monographs, commentaries on international conventions and collections of legal acts in Ukrainian, English, Slovak and other foreign languages.

**Electronic catalogue:**

Literature searches are carried out through the Web-LIS system, which is available on the library website (lib.uzhnu.edu.ua). Users may verify the availability of titles online and place requests.

**Institutional repository (eUzhNUIR):**

An important component is the digital archive, in which scholarly works of academic staff, conference materials and students' qualification theses are stored, thereby ensuring open access to the university's scholarly outputs.

**2. Access to international scholarly databases**

By virtue of the state university, students and teachers have access to leading global platforms, which is essential for research in the field of international law.

**3. Legal information systems**

For the practical preparation of lawyers specialising in international law, access is ensured to systems containing current legislation and case law:

**Information and analytical system "LIGA:ZAKON":** the main source of legal regulations of Ukraine and analytical materials.  
**Database "Legislation of Ukraine":** the official portal of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine.  
**HUDOC (ECtHR):** access to the database of decisions of the European Court of Human Rights, which constitutes an essential element of education in this field.

**4. Publishing activity and methodological support**

The Faculty of Law of UŽNU carries out active publishing activity with the aim of providing students with its own textbooks and teaching materials.

**Scientific Bulletin of UŽNU (Series: Law):**

A professional journal in which the results of current research in the field of international and European law are published.

**Methodological support in the Moodle system:**

All courses of the study programme in International Law are covered by electronic courses on the distance learning platform (e-learn.uzhnu.edu.ua). Students have access to syllabi, lectures and reading lists on a 24/7 basis.

**5. Infrastructure and accessibility**

**Reading rooms:**

Reading rooms equipped with computers and free Wi-Fi connection (UzhNU-Free network) are available in the main library building and at the faculty.

**Inclusion:**

The library and faculty premises are arranged with regard to the needs of students with special needs, including barrier-free entrances and access to digital content.

**6. Organisational support**

Coordination of access to IT services and network resources is ensured by the Information Technology Centre (CIT) of UŽNU. Each student receives a university e-mail account (@uzhnu.edu.ua), which serves as access to licences for Microsoft 365 or Google Workspace.

- c) Characteristics and scope of distance education applied in the study program with assignment to subjects. Accesses, manuals of e-learning portals. Procedures for the transition from attendance education to distance education.

**For PraF UK:**

Within the study programme in question, educational activities are to be carried out primarily by means of the full-time (in-person) method, i.e. a form of study based on teaching with direct contact between the lecturer and students. However, the "COVID years" have demonstrated the necessity of ensuring also a form of distance education for emergency situations and of having procedures in place for the transition from in-person to distance learning. At the same time, distance education has already been conducted at PraF UK for several years within part-time study, which constitutes a good basis for teaching in the combined method prescribed for this study programme.

At the same time, the faculty, in cooperation with the Information Technology Centre of Comenius University, provides support for distance education to students and staff. Basic information on how such support is provided may be found here: <https://uniba.sk/elearning/>

**For PraF UŽNU:**

Within the study programme in International Law, educational activities are carried out primarily by means of the full-time (in-person) method, based on direct contact between the lecturer and students. However, experience from previous years (COVID-19 pandemic, security situation) has led to the full integration of elements of distance education, enabling a flexible transition to a combined method of study.

**Platforms and e-learning tools**

Uzhhorod National University uses a unified digital ecosystem to support distance education, including:

**E-learn UŽNU (Moodle):**

The main e-learning portal of the faculty (e-learn.uzhnu.edu.ua), where each course has its own virtual classroom. It contains syllabi, electronic teaching materials, tests and assignments for independent work.

#### **Google Workspace for Education:**

Each student and staff member is assigned a university account providing access to tools such as:

- **Google Meet:** for real-time online lectures and seminars,
- **Google Classroom:** for operational communication and submission of assignments,
- **Google Drive:** for sharing extensive study materials and legal databases.

#### **2. Manuals and support for e-learning**

The university, through the Information Technology Centre (CIT), provides methodological and technical support. The UŽNU e-learning information portal includes:

- instructional videos and manuals for working in the Moodle system (for students and teaching staff),
- methodological guidelines for conducting online examinations and state final examinations,
- rules of digital etiquette for online teaching.

#### **3. Procedures for transition from in-person to distance education**

Where necessary (state of emergency, quarantine), the faculty applies a predefined protocol for transition to distance learning:

1. **Issuance of a rector's/dean's order:** official determination of the timing and scope of distance teaching,
  2. **Activation of virtual classrooms:** transfer of the timetable into the Google Meet/Moodle environment,
  3. **Quality monitoring:** heads of departments and vice-deans for educational activities monitor the course of online teaching and student participation through Moodle system reports,
  4. **Communication:** all instructions are communicated to students via university e-mail and published in the electronic timetable system.
5. **IT support**  
At UŽNU, the Information Technology Centre (CIT) serves as a single point of contact for IT support. The CIT provides:
- administration of user accounts and access to systems,
  - technical assistance in case of problems with connection to the university network or e-learning portals,
  - training for teaching staff in the use of modern educational technologies.

The Faculty of Law of UŽNU, in close cooperation with its partners (including Comenius University in Bratislava), continuously modernises its procedures in order to ensure continuity and a high quality of education even under extraordinary conditions. Distance learning tools are also used during regular in-person teaching to enhance self-study and access to international legal resources.

- d) University partners in realization of educational activities of the study programme and characteristics of their participation.

#### **For PraF UK:**

Comenius University in Bratislava maintains and since its establishment in 1919 expands international contacts with important European educational institutions. It is part of the most important European university associations. It is a member of the European University Association (EUA), Network of Universities from the Capitals of Europe (UNICA), Utrecht Network (UN), Danube Rectors' Conference (DRC), European Association for International Education (EAIE), Virtual Technology Library Systems (VTLS ) and many others.

An important role is played by the fact that the Slovak Republic has been a member of the European Union since May 1, 2004, and since 2000 also a member of the OECD. In connection with the participation of the Comenius University in Bratislava in the Lifelong Learning Program/Erasmus (LLP/Erasmus from 01.01.2007, Erasmus+ from 01.06.2014), the number of bilateral contracts concluded by the faculties of the Comenius University in Bratislava with their foreign partners has increased significantly. Consequently, this enables a significant increase in the number of mobilities of students as well as workers (academic and administrative) at the Comenius University in Bratislava. Cooperation with universities in the USA and Canada, Taiwan, Japan, Australia and South America is also expanding. In addition, the interest in participating in Central European programs such as CEEPUS, Visegrad fund, Action Austria - Slovakia, etc., is not decreasing at the Comenius University in Bratislava.

Faculty of Law, as a part of the Comenius University in Bratislava, tries to respond to developments in the European educational space, especially in those areas where it benefits its students, teaching, and research staff. It develops international contacts based on bilateral and multilateral agreements.

In 2020, of Faculty of Law concluded a framework agreement with the Slovak Academy of Sciences (Slovenská akadémia vied, hereinafter referred to as "SAS"), the Institute of State and Law (Ústav štátu a práva, hereinafter referred to as "ÚŠaP") on cooperation with an external educational institution in the implementation of doctoral study programs in the field of study 30. Law according to § 54 of Act no. 131/2002 Coll. on universities and on the amendment of certain laws. The subject of the Framework Agreement is the cooperation between of Faculty of Law and ÚŠaP SAS in the implementation of doctoral studies in study programme in the field 30. Law, carried out at of Faculty of Law in internal and external form in Slovak, or in another languages according to the valid accreditation of the study programme.

At the faculty level, cooperation has recently been established with many other partners from the public as well as the private sector. Within the public sector, Cooperation Agreements were signed with many institutions such as the Ministry of Justice of the Slovak Republic, the Ministry of Health of the Slovak Republic, the Bratislava I District Court, the Slovak Bar Association, the Prosecutor General of the Slovak Republic, the Slovak Land Fund, the Office for the Management of Seized Assets, the Office of Nuclear Supervision of the Slovak Republic, Office for Industrial Property of the Slovak Republic and many others. In summary, it can be stated that by 2025, Faculty of Law has concluded 74 Agreements/Memorandums on cooperation with public and private entities. Within the framework of these agreements, cooperating subjects, within which experts from the given field work, mostly undertake to participate in the teaching, pedagogical, educational process in the form of conducting seminars, lectures, trainings. In addition, experts from practice can also hold the position of consultants when processing final (dissertation) theses. Within the scope of the Agreements/Memorandums on cooperation in question, the cooperating subjects provide, within their capacity and personnel options, internships for Faculty of Law students within their organization or companies, where students, to a certain extent, help the cooperating subject, but also themselves, to increase practical skills outside Faculty of Law.

In conclusion, let us add that Faculty of Law also organizes many conferences, workshops, trainings, and thus contributes to the development of knowledge in all branches of law within the framework of scientific and research activities. In 2024, the Faculty of Law organized many scientific events on various topics, among which it is possible to mention the international scientific conference Bratislava Legal Forum, the main topic of which was "Influence of the European law on national legal orders". As part of the conference in question, parallel negotiations were held in eleven thematically focused sections, in which attention was paid to current legal issues and problems in the context of the influence of the European law on national legal orders.

Then we can mention the conference entitled "Milestones of Law in Central Europe"; the conference "Transparency of the Public Sector and Open Government at National and Regional Level"; the conference "Disinformation and Freedom of Speech in Modern Society"; the conference "Legal and Ethical Aspects of Disciplinary Responsibility of Judges", etc.

#### **For PraF UŽNU:**

Since its establishment in 1945, UŽNU has systematically built a network of international and national partnerships. UŽNU is an active member of major European and global academic associations, such as the European University Association, the Danube Rectors' Conference and the Association of Carpathian Region Universities.

Given the strategic geographical location of the university on the borders with four EU countries (Slovakia, Hungary, Poland, Romania), cross-border cooperation plays a key role. The faculty actively participates in the Erasmus+ programme (student and staff mobility) and in capacity-building projects (KA2), which directly influence the quality of teaching in international law.

#### **1. International partnerships and joint programmes**

The Faculty of Law of UŽNU develops cooperation with foreign universities on the basis of bilateral agreements, with key partners including:

- Comenius University in Bratislava (Slovakia): strategic partnership focused on the development of joint study plans, harmonisation of Ukrainian legal education with EU standards and the implementation of research stays,
- Charles University in Prague (Czech Republic): scientific cooperation in the field of comparative legal science and private international law,
- Pomeranian Academy in Słupsk (Poland): implementation of "double degree" programmes enabling students to obtain education in line with European standards.

#### **2. Cooperation with the public sector (national level)**

At the faculty level, memoranda have been concluded with key state authorities, ensuring a high level of practical training of students:

- Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine: cooperation in the preparation of specialists in international law, lectures delivered by practitioners from diplomacy and student internships at consular offices,
- Ministry of Justice of Ukraine: organisation of professional internships within state administration bodies and registries,

- judicial authorities: cooperation agreements with the Zakarpattia Court of Appeal, the Commercial Court and the Administrative Court; judges participate in the educational process as guest lecturers and key stakeholders in the development of study programmes,
- State Customs and Border Service of Ukraine: specific partnership arising from the border status of the region, essential for courses focused on customs and international law.

### **3. Cooperation with the private sector and non-governmental organisations**

The faculty maintains intensive interaction with legal practice and international organisations:

- Bar Association of the Zakarpattia Region: practising lawyers conduct practical seminars focused on professional ethics and legal skills,
- International Renaissance Foundation and partners of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (e.g. NGO "NEEKA"): cooperation in the field of protection of the rights of refugees and stateless persons, which is essential for students of international law,
- leading law firms in the region: provide a basis for professional internships and act as potential employers of graduates.

### **4. Legal Clinic of UŽNU (clinical education)**

The practical component of education is ensured by the Legal Clinic of UŽNU, which operates on the basis of interactive methods. Participation of partners includes:

- mentoring: experienced lawyers and activists supervise the quality of legal advice provided by students to disadvantaged groups,
- workshops: delivery of training in "soft skills", client interviewing and courtroom advocacy.

### **5. Scientific and professional events**

Regular international forums enable the exchange of knowledge between partners:

- International scientific and practical conference "Zakarpattia Legal Readings": an event with participation of representatives of partner universities from Slovakia, the Czech Republic, Poland and Hungary,
- Summer schools of international and European law: organised jointly with foreign partners for in-depth study of current issues of integration.

### **Summary of partner participation:**

All of the above-mentioned partners participate in:

1. monitoring the quality of education: commenting on study programmes from the perspective of employers,
2. teaching activities: delivering lectures, seminars and professional workshops,
3. supervision of internships: providing capacity for student placements,
4. professional evaluation: reviewing and examining final theses (bachelor's and master's).

#### **e) Characteristics of the possibilities of social, sports, cultural, spiritual and social activities.**

The characteristics of the possibilities of social, sports, cultural, spiritual and social activities of the student need to be divided into two levels, namely the university level and the faculty level.

At the university level, a wide spectrum of services is offered, which are provided through the Comenius University in Bratislava and its parts. At the faculty level, first of all it's worth to mention the sports activities that can make law students' studies more varied. These activities are mainly provided by the Institute of Physical Culture, which is a specialised department of the Faculty of Law of the Comenius University dealing with sport in its entire range. The main aim is to provide educational, training, professional-consulting and motivational process. In addition to the pedagogical process, the institute prepares various sports and recreational activities and professionally leads the faculty's representative teams in the university league. Employees of the institute in question are active in the sport-organizational structures of university and top-level sport.

The Institute of Physical Culture provides pedagogical process in several types of sports: basketball, volleyball, floorball, futsal, frisbee, badminton, ping pong, aerobics, body forming, fitness, step aerobics, exercises for good health, fitness and cardio fitness, cross fit, and strength training, bootcamp, pilates and canoeing. Swimming and wall climbing are also on offer, but these activities are chargeable. The aim of the exercises is the development of fitness, training, and improvement of skills specific to the sport and last but not least, compensation (psychohygiene) of the student's mental health and motivation of the student to repeated sporting activity. Sports activities for students are also offered during the exam period in the form of skiing and hiking courses. The performance component of the institute consists of rep teams of the university league in volleyball, basketball, floorball, futsal, and swimming.

At the same time, it should be noted that students and employees of the Faculty of Law have modern sports facilities at their disposal, namely a sports hall, a movement studio, a gym, as well as associated changing rooms and showers, while the above-mentioned premises are located in the basement of the New building of the Faculty of Law in Bratislava, and all underwent a complete reconstruction in 2017-2019. The Institute of Physical Culture ensures the pedagogical process in these premises, as well as supervises them. For more information regarding the activities of the institute, see here:

#### **For PraF UŽNU:**

The characteristics of opportunities for social, sports, cultural, spiritual and societal engagement of a student of the Faculty of Law of UŽNU should be divided into two levels, namely the university-wide level and the faculty level.

#### **University-wide**

**level**

At the university level, UŽNU offers a broad spectrum of services and activities for the comprehensive development of students:

##### **- Accommodation, catering and social support:**

The university operates six student dormitories located near the main buildings and within the university campus. Student canteens and buffets form part of the campus infrastructure. The university also provides social and merit-based scholarships.

##### **- Sports and recreation:**

Sports facilities are primarily ensured by the Department of Physical Education of UŽNU in cooperation with the "Burevisnyk" Sports Complex. Available facilities include:

- indoor sports halls (for basketball, volleyball, futsal),
- a 25-metre swimming pool,
- outdoor sports grounds and running tracks,
- gyms and fitness zones located directly in certain dormitories (e.g. Dormitory No. 4). The university regularly organises Spartakiads and supports university teams in football, rugby and American football ("Uzhhorod Lumberjacks"), in which law students also frequently participate.

##### **- Culture and social life:**

The centre of cultural life at the university is the Student Initiatives Centre and the Student Council. Regularly organised events include:

- Freshman Day (initiation into the student community),
- talent competitions (Miss UŽNU, Student Autumn/Spring),
- charity fairs, film evenings and quizzes (intellectual games such as "What? Where? When?"),
- activities of the university choir and dance ensembles.

##### **- Spiritual life and psychological support:**

A volunteer and chaplaincy centre operates on the university premises near the campus, providing spiritual support. For students requiring professional assistance, a free Central Psychological Service of UŽNU is available, offering support in coping with stress and adaptation.

#### **Faculty level (Faculty of Law)**

In addition to university-wide opportunities, the Faculty of Law, and in particular students of International Law, have their own specialised activities combining social engagement with professional development:

##### **- Law student associations:**

The faculty hosts active branches of the League of Students of the Ukrainian Bar Association (UBA, Uzhhorod branch) and the European Law Students' Association (ELSA Uzhhorod). These organisations integrate academic and social life and regularly organise:

- informal meetings with successful graduates and practising lawyers ("Lawyer's Coffee"),
- moot court competitions combined with social networking events,
- team-building activities and excursions for members (including trips to the Carpathian region).

##### **- Faculty events:**

The Student Council of the Faculty of Law organises its own social events, such as Lawyers' Day (including a cultural programme and awards for the best students and teachers), Christmas charity collections for children's homes and themed quiz evenings held directly on faculty premises.

##### **- Sports at the faculty:**

Although the faculty does not have its own separate sports hall (it uses the central Burevisnyk complex), it annually organises the Dean's Cup in futsal, in which teams of individual year groups as well as a team of academic staff participate. The Department of International Law also frequently supports hiking trips to the mountains (e.g. Hoverla and others) for students of the programme.

The combination of university-wide and faculty-level activities creates a comprehensive environment for mental well-being, development of soft skills and the building of social relationships during studies.

- f) Opportunities and conditions for students of the study programme to participate in mobility and internships (with contact details), application guidelines, rules for recognition of this type of education.

Comenius University has maintained and expanded international contacts with major European educational institutions since its foundation in 1919. It is part of the most important European university associations. It is a member of the European University Association (EUA), Network of Universities from the Capitals of Europe (UNICA), Utrecht Network (UN), Danube Rectors' Conference (DRC), European Association for International Education (EAIE), Virtual Technology Library Systems (VTLS) and many others.

The fact that the Slovak Republic has been a member of the European Union since 1 May 2004 and a member of the OECD since 2000 plays an important role. In connection with the participation of the Comenius University in the Lifelong Learning Programme/Erasmus (LLP/Erasmus since 01.01.2007, Erasmus+ since 01.06.2014), the number of bilateral agreements concluded by the faculties of the Comenius University with their foreign partners has increased significantly. Consequently, this allows for a significant increase in the number of student and staff mobility (both academic and administrative) at Comenius University. In terms of the number of students sent and received, the Comenius University is the leader in this programme in Slovakia. We are pleased that at the same time there is a growing interest in studying at the Comenius University, which is mainly due to the fact that several faculties of the Comenius University offer complete or extensive education in English. Under the Erasmus+ programme, the ratio between outgoing and incoming students is 2:1, with the percentage of home and international students at the Comenius University being 2.5%. Cooperation with universities in the USA and Canada, Taiwan, Japan, Australia, and South America is also expanding. In addition, the Comenius University is also interested in participating in Central European programmes such as CEEPUS, Visegrad fund, Action Austria-Slovakia, etc.

As a part of the Comenius University in Bratislava, the Faculty of Law of the Comenius University in Bratislava tries to respond to the developments in the European educational area, especially in those areas where it brings benefits to its students, pedagogical and scientific staff. It develops international contacts on the basis of bilateral and multilateral agreements.

#### **For PraF UŽNU:**

UŽNU actively develops international cooperation and forms an integral part of the European Higher Education Area. The university is a member of prestigious international academic associations, such as the European University Association, the Danube Rectors' Conference and the Association of Carpathian Region Universities.

A key role in internationalisation is played by UŽNU's participation in the European Union programme Erasmus+ (Key Action 1 – Learning Mobility of Individuals). As Ukraine participates in the programme as a partner country, the number of bilateral agreements concluded by UŽNU faculties with their foreign partners has significantly increased. The programme enables students, as well as academic and administrative staff, to undertake part of their studies or an internship at partner universities within the European Union. For students of the Faculty of Law, particularly in the field of international law, the ongoing adaptation of study programmes to European standards is of key importance, as it significantly facilitates and enhances mobility opportunities.

The Faculty of Law of UŽNU responds flexibly to developments within the European Higher Education Area. Based on bilateral and multilateral agreements, the faculty enables students to undertake semester-long study stays at partner institutions, notably including close and long-term cooperation with Comenius University in Bratislava. In addition to the Erasmus+ programme, students actively participate in Central European programmes such as the International Visegrad Fund (Visegrad Fund), CEEPUS and other bilateral scholarship schemes.

#### **Types of mobility:**

Within the Erasmus+ programme and academic mobility, students may undertake:

- **Student Mobility for Studies:** a period of study at a partner higher education institution abroad, usually lasting one semester,
- **Student Mobility for Traineeships:** a period spent in a foreign enterprise, institution or organisation; the purpose of the traineeship is to assist students in adapting to the requirements of the international labour market and acquiring practical professional skills in legal practice.

#### **Application procedures:**

The selection process for academic mobility is transparent and is conducted on the basis of an official call published by the International Relations Office of UŽNU and the Dean's Office of the Faculty of Law. Students are generally required to submit the following documents:

- curriculum vitae (in English or in the language of instruction of the receiving institution),
- motivation letter,
- transcript of records including the calculated grade average,
- certificate demonstrating the level of foreign language proficiency (usually at least B1/B2 according to the CEFR).

The selection of candidates is carried out by a faculty or university selection committee, which assesses academic performance, language competencies and the overall motivation of the applicant.

#### **Rules for recognition of education (ECTS):**

Recognition of the results of academic mobility at UŽNU is governed by the internal Regulation on the Procedure for the Exercise of the Right to Academic Mobility. The fundamental pillar of recognition is a pre-approved Learning Agreement. This document is concluded prior to departure for mobility and is signed by the student, the sending institution (Faculty of Law of UŽNU) and the receiving institution. After successful completion of the mobility abroad, the student submits a Transcript of Records to the home faculty. Courses and

corresponding ECTS credits successfully completed abroad in accordance with the approved Learning Agreement are fully recognised and recorded in the student's study plan within the UŽNU system, thereby preventing prolongation of studies.

**9. Required abilities and prerequisites of a candidate for the study programme**

a) Required abilities and prerequisites for admission.

An applicant may submit an application for the cross-border joint study programme either at **PraF UK** or at **PraF UŽNU** in the same manner and following the same procedure as is customary for applications for study at the respective faculty.

**For PraF UK:**

The conditions for admission to study at Comenius University in Bratislava, Faculty of Law, pursuant to Section 57 of Act No. 131/2002 Coll. on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments and Supplements to Certain Acts, as amended, and the information pursuant to Article 3(5) of the consolidated version of Internal Regulation No. 4/2021 – Rules of the Admission Procedure at Comenius University in Bratislava (Internal Regulation No. 24/2023), will be available at:

**For PraF UŽNU:**

**Specifics of the admission procedure for foreign applicants at UŽNU**

In contrast to domestic applicants, who undergo the National Multi-Subject Test (NMT), foreign applicants at UŽNU generally undergo a specific procedure:

- **Entrance interview:** foreign applicants are admitted on the basis of successful completion of an entrance interview in profile subjects (Fundamentals of Law, History) and a language test,
- **Language competence:**
  - for studies in English, an internationally recognised certificate (IELTS, TOEFL, etc.) at a minimum level of B2 is required,
  - in the case of studies in Ukrainian, the applicant may complete a one-year language preparatory programme at the Preparatory Department for Foreign Citizens of UŽNU,
- **Assessment of previous academic performance:** an important factor is the grade average achieved in the secondary school leaving examination (maturita) in relevant subjects (humanities, languages).

**3. Skills and competences of the profile applicant**

In addition to formal requirements, the selection process (in particular within motivation letters and interviews) places emphasis on:

- **Intercultural sensitivity:** the ability to perceive and respect differences between various legal systems (continental law vs. common law) and the cultural specificities of international relations,
- **Language flexibility:** a prerequisite for success in the joint programme is the willingness to learn the basics of the language of the partner country (Slovak/Ukrainian) for better integration into the academic community,
- **Critical thinking and argumentation:** the ability to analyse international conflicts, interpret international treaties and formulate persuasive legal arguments in a foreign language,
- **Global awareness:** an interest in global challenges such as human rights, international security, environmental protection and the digital transformation of law.

**4. Information for applicants from EU and third countries**

UŽNU: The Office for Work with Foreign Students and the Dean's Office of the Faculty of Law provide counselling in English and Slovak.

**Important note:**

All applicants, regardless of nationality, are assessed on the basis of the principle of equal treatment and non-discrimination. The joint study programme promotes diversity and creates conditions for the integration of students from different socio-economic and cultural backgrounds.

**For PraF UŽNU:**

**Procedure at the Faculty of Law of UŽNU (for applicants from Ukraine)**

The admission procedure for Ukrainian citizens is governed by the current Admission Rules of UŽNU, approved by the Academic Senate of UŽNU in accordance with the regulations of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.

- Electronic application: applicants submit their application electronically via the state portal (vstup.edbo.gov.ua) within the prescribed deadlines,
- National Multi-Subject Test (NMT): the basis for ranking is formed by the results of the NMT in prescribed subjects (Ukrainian language, history of Ukraine, mathematics and an elective subject – a foreign language is recommended),
- Motivation letter: each applicant is required to submit a motivation letter uploaded directly into the electronic system,
- Ranking: on the basis of the competitive score (a combination of NMT results and weighting coefficients), a list of applicants proposed for admission is generated.

**2. Procedure for foreign applicants (at UŽNU)**

Foreign applicants (including citizens of the Slovak Republic and other EU countries) who choose UŽNU as their home institution follow a specific regime:

- Submission of documents: applicants contact the Office for Work with Foreign Students of UŽNU; documents on previous education must be officially translated and legalised (apostille/recognition),
- Admission examination/interview: foreign applicants are admitted on the basis of successful completion of an entrance interview in profile subjects and verification of language competence (depending on the chosen language of instruction – Ukrainian or English),
- Invitation letter: upon successful assessment of documents and interview, the university issues an official invitation letter for study purposes to obtain a visa (if required).

**3. Procedure at the Faculty of Law of Comenius University in Bratislava**

For applicants who choose Comenius University in Bratislava as their home institution, the admission procedure is conducted fully in accordance with Slovak legislation and the internal regulations of the university.

- Legislative framework: admission is governed by Internal Regulation No. 24/2023 (consolidated version of Internal Regulation No. 4/2021), which defines the rules of the admission procedure at Comenius University in Bratislava,
- Electronic application: submitted via the AIS2 system (or an external application portal),
- Admission criteria: applicants are selected based on the results of national tests (e.g. SCIO – General Study Prerequisites and Foundations of Social Sciences) or other criteria determined by the faculty for the relevant academic year,
- Information for applicants: detailed procedures and current deadlines are published on the PraF UK website: <https://www.flaw.uniba.sk/studium/uchadzac-prijimacie-konanie/>

**4. Joint provisions and enrolment**

- Admission decision: after processing the results, the competent authority (rector or dean) issues a written decision on admission to study,
- Enrolment: a successful applicant becomes a student of the joint programme on the date of enrolment at the home institution; the home institution subsequently informs the partner institution of the number and list of enrolled students for the purposes of joint administration and teaching,
- Fees: information on administrative fees related to the admission procedure is published in the fee schedules of both universities for the relevant academic year.

The admission procedure will be implemented for the first time in relation to the academic year 2026/2027.

**10. Feedback on the quality of education provided**

a) Procedures for monitoring and evaluating students' views on the quality of the study programme.

**For PraF UK:**

Monitoring and evaluation of students' views on the quality of the study programme is mainly carried out through anonymous survey evaluation.

An anonymous questionnaire evaluation is carried out at the end of each semester by means of a questionnaire in the AIS 2 system.

Students evaluate the quality of the study programme through open-ended questions, scaled assessment and course-specific grading.

**PraF UŽNU:**

Monitoring and evaluation of students' opinions on the quality of the study programme in International Law constitute a key element of the internal quality assurance system of higher education at the Faculty of Law of UŽNU. The objective of these procedures is to implement the principle of student-centred learning and to ensure the continuous improvement of the content and forms of teaching.

**Procedures for monitoring and evaluating students' opinions**

The feedback mechanism at Uzhhorod National University is organised systematically and operates on several levels:

**1. Anonymous surveys:**

- The principal instrument is anonymous survey evaluation, which is generally conducted at the end of each semester or academic year,
- The survey is carried out electronically via the UŽNU Student Electronic Cabinet (internal university information system) or through specialised questionnaires prepared by the Centre for Quality Assurance of Education at UŽNU,
- Students are given the opportunity to express their views on the quality of teaching of individual courses, the professional competence of teaching staff, the objectivity of assessment, as well as the overall organisation of the study process.

**2. Structure of evaluation:**

The questionnaires combine closed questions (scaled satisfaction ratings and grading), enabling quantitative data analysis, and open-ended questions, through which students may formulate specific comments, proposals for changes in syllabi or suggestions for improving material and technical support.

**3. Direct communication and student self-governance:**

- Students' opinions are also regularly monitored through meetings with the guarantor of the study programme and the dean of the faculty,
- An important role is played by the Student Council of the Faculty of Law, whose representatives are members of the Academic Senate of the faculty and the Education Quality Council; in this manner, students have a direct impact on decision-making processes concerning modifications of the study programme.

**4. Processing and use of results:**

- The results of anonymous surveys are processed at the level of the dean's office and departments (in particular the Department of International Law),
- Summary reports on feedback results are discussed at meetings of departments and the Faculty Council,
- Where deficiencies are identified, the faculty management adopts corrective measures, which may include modification of course content, changes in teaching methodology or personnel changes in course provision.

**5. Transparency:**

The university ensures that students are informed about measures adopted on the basis of their feedback, thereby strengthening students' trust in the quality monitoring process and their motivation to participate in the development of the faculty.

- b) Results of student feedback and related measures to improve the quality of the study programme.

**PraF UK:**

The results of the survey evaluation are accessible to individual teachers, heads of departments and directors of institutes, as well as to the faculty management. At the same time, summary data for individual courses are published, together with recalculated trimmed means, which better represent evaluation trends and eliminate distorting extreme values.

The evaluation of feedback and students' suggestions obtained from the survey evaluation is carried out in three phases:

1. at the first level, suggestions are discussed at individual departments and institutes of PraF UK within the overall evaluation of survey results;
2. subsequently, an evaluation is carried out at the level of the Quality Council of PraF UK;
3. the results of the survey evaluation (including students' suggestions) are also available to the Scientific Council of PraF UK and their assessment forms Part II of the Annual Report of PraF UK, prepared on an annual basis.

Heads of departments/directors of institutes and the dean of the faculty, where serious deficiencies are identified on the basis of the evaluation results, adopt appropriate measures to improve the quality of the teaching process.

The Scientific Council of PraF UK has called upon heads of departments and directors of institutes to ensure that the evaluation of survey results is recorded in the minutes of meetings of the respective department/institute. This practice has been implemented for several years and is recorded and summarised within the activities of the Quality Council of PraF UK.

**PraF UŽNU:**

The evaluation of students' suggestions obtained from survey evaluations and other forms of feedback is carried out at the Faculty of Law of UŽNU at three levels:

**1. Department level:**

At the first stage, the results and specific comments of students are discussed in detail at meetings of the respective departments. Heads of departments analyse suggestions concerning course content, teaching methodology and the approach of teaching staff. A record of this evaluation forms part of the minutes of the department meeting.

**2. Level of the Education Quality Council:**

Following the faculty-level processes, evaluation is carried out at the level of the Education Quality Council of UŽNU. This body monitors compliance with quality standards and proposes systemic measures to improve the study environment.

**3. Level of the Scientific Council and faculty management:**

The overall results of survey evaluations, including the measures adopted, are available to the Scientific Council of the faculty. These data form an important part of the Annual Report on the Activities of the Faculty, which is prepared annually and serves as a basis for strategic planning of the development of study programmes.

Where deficiencies in the quality of the teaching process are identified on the basis of the evaluation, heads of departments, in cooperation with the dean of the faculty, adopt appropriate measures. These may include:

- Updating of syllabi: modification of course content to better reflect current developments in international law or the requirements of practice,
- Didactic innovations: introduction of new forms of teaching (e.g. strengthening interactive seminars, simulated court proceedings – moot courts),
- Personnel and organisational changes: optimisation of teaching schedules or adjustments to teaching staff assignments for specific courses,
- Material and technical improvements: modernisation of teaching aids and access to electronic information resources.

- c) The results of alumni feedback and related measures to improve the quality of the study programme.

It should be added that the Faculty of Law in Bratislava has long been based on good relations with its graduates. This is also demonstrated by the establishment of the Alumni Club, which brings together many alumni of the Faculty of Law. The club focuses primarily on:

- creating and deepening the ties between the Faculty of Law and between the faculty's alumni with each other and strengthening the sense of belonging of the faculty's alumni,
- organising meetings of alumni of the Faculty of Law of the Comenius University, usually at the faculty,
- organizing professional and social events with the active participation of alumni of the Faculty of Law of the Comenius University to promote the activities of Faculty of Law of the Comenius University and its alumni,
- support of graduates of the Faculty of Law of the Comenius University in their professional activities,
- support for the activities of the Faculty of Law of the Comenius University,
- motivating students of the Faculty of Law of the Comenius University,
- assisting Faculty of Law of the Comenius University in publishing publications for members of the Alumni Club and alumni of Faculty of Law of the Comenius University,
- organizing communication activities towards members of the Alumni Club and alumni of Faculty of Law of the Comenius University.

It is also the long-term and continuous dialogue with many graduates of the Faculty of Law of the Comenius University, who are successfully conducting their legal practice, which in many ways helps the faculty in obtaining the necessary feedback on the study of law and significantly supports the development of further activities of the Faculty of Law of the Comenius University.
