## 1. The purpose and objectives of the discipline

**Metha** - teaching discipline is to provide vocational training of students in the specialty " International Economic Relations " and consists in the formation of future specialists a system of special knowledge on the problems of development and the current state of international economic relations on the basis of studying patterns of interaction between national economies and international economic organizations in the areas of international exchange of goods, movement of production factors and the formation of international economic policy of states in the current conditions of globalization..

### 6. Control methods

Assessment of knowledge, skills and practical skills of a student in the discipline "International organizations" is carried out according to a 100-points system.

Assessment of students' knowledge is carried out on the basis of results:

- ongoing knowledge control;
- final control of knowledge – exam.

#### **8.1. The current control of students' knowledge is carried out in two components:**

- control of systematicity and activity of the student's work during the semester;
- control over the implementation of modular tasks.

When controlling the systematicity and activity of the student's work, the assessment is subject to:

- attend seminars;
- activity in seminars;
- level of knowledge of program material.

**Methods of evaluation:** express survey; ongoing testing; solving situational problems; compiling a dictionary of foreign terms on the topic; a summary on the topic; an abstract of additionally studied literature; an assessment of an individual project; a final control survey.

Ongoing testing (modular control)

During the semester, students perform one modular task, which is rated in the range from 0 to 50 points. The maximum score of modular control is 50 points.

A student who, according to the results of control of systematicity and activity of current work at seminars and independent work, received 0 points, is NOT ALLOWED to modular control.

### 7. Final assessment in discipline

The total final score consists of the sum of points based on the results of control of systematicity and activity of the student's work during the semester and the final number of modular control points.
