

AGREEMENT

ON CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITY OF ZAGREB (CROATIA) AND UZHGOROD NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (UKRAINE)

The University of Zagreb (Croatia) in the person of Rector prof. A. Bjeliš from one side and Uzhhorod National University (Ukraine) in the person of Rector prof. M. Vehesh, which acts on the bases of statute, from the other side agree to stimulate and mutually support co-operative relationship, which will emphasise the development of collaborative educational and research projects. Both universities will encourage direct contact and co-operation between their faculty members, departments, institutes and other research centres subject to the provisions of this Agreement.

1.

Within the fields of study to be mutually designated, the University of Zagreb and Uzhhorod National University agree to the following general forms of co-operation:

- The exchange of academic staff
- The exchange of administrative and professional staff
- The exchange of students
- Joint organization of courses, study tours, conferences and seminars
- Organisation of Joint Master Programmes and Doctoral Studies – especially taking into account possibilities of joint programmes in the Centre for Advanced Academic Studies of the University of Zagreb in Dubrovnik
- Joint research projects, including applications for governmental and foundation funding
- Promote exchanges in the fields of sports, music, theatre, dance and other artistic and athletic fields
- Other forms of university co-operation of mutual interest.

2.

Each university will name a liaison person who will be responsible for co-ordinating activities related to this Agreement. On behalf of the University of Zagreb, the International Relations Office shall be the co-ordinating body. On behalf of Uzhhorod National University the International Relations Department shall be the co-ordinating body.

3.

Terms of joint activities, the conditions for utilising the results achieved, and arrangements for specific visits, exchanges and other forms of co-operation will be negotiated for each specific activity. It is also understood that any financial arrangements will be negotiated and agreed to in writing for each specific case and will depend upon the availability of funds.

Travel expenses for the academic and research staff will be covered by the sending university; living expenses (accommodation and per diem) by the receiving university. The hosting Faculties of the University of Zagreb will provide for living expenses for incoming academic and research staff and will provide for travel expenses for outgoing academic and research staff according to the basic structural subsidiary principle of the university and its faculties (which includes financial subsidiarity as well).

4.

Exchange of academic staff, research scientists, yearly quotas, duration of their stay will be defined in a separately prepared working programme. This working programme can be rearranged every three years in accordance of the proposals of the parties to meet the new demands and requirements.

5.

The student exchange will be regulated by the special agreement and/or the working programme between the institutions.

6.

The universities stated that the medical insurance expenses during the stay will be covered by participants in the exchange programme.




This Agreement will become effective upon the date of signature by the representatives of the two universities. Amendments may be incorporated with the mutual written consent of both universities. The representative of either university may terminate the Agreement by written notice at least six months before its date of expiry. Such termination shall not affect the rights of anybody exchanged under this Agreement prior to receipt of such notice.

The agreement drew up in two original copies in Ukrainian, Croatian and English languages, which have the same juridical force.
