Working languages: Ukrainian, English, Russian, German, Slovak, Czech, Hungarian, Romanian, Polish, and Belarusian.

Requirements to the Execution

A scholarly article must be written on current issues, include a profound scholarly study without plagiarism.

The article is to consist of up to 7 pages, text editor – Microsoft Word, orientation – portrait, margins – 20 mm, font – Times New Roman, size – 14, spacing between the lines – 1.5.

The first line – the report title (in capital letters, boldface, centered).

The second line – surname and initials of the author (boldface, right-aligned).

The third line – position, scholarly degree, academic status (or course and location of the educational establishment).

Then the text of the report follows.

At the end of the article one is to provide information about a supervisor (for PhD students / students).

References in the text are to be made page by page with the footnotes mode.

The electronic version of the report must be called the author's name and written in a .doc format (e.g. Johnson.doc).
