
Mrs. Diana Haydanka (PhD, associate professor at the English Philology Department, Uzhhorod National University) applied for the internship at the Faculty of Philosophy and Arts at Trnava University in Trnava for the period from 15.02.2021 to 01.03.2021 and successfully completed it on the due date under the supervision of Dr. Marcel Martinkovič, the head of the Political Science Department.

The main aim of Diana Haydanka's internship was knowledge exchange in the sphere of political and content analysis. Mrs. Haydanka implemented the research project entitled "Markers of Populism in Political Discourse (on the example of speeches by Volodymyr Zelensky and Igor Matovič) as a source of possible inspirations for further research into linguistic content analysis, speech-writing, image-making, and media literacy.

Mrs. Haydanka completed the internship of 120 hours with rigour and full stretch, regularly consulting the internship supervisor Dr. Martinkovič to see to the progress of the abovementioned internship. She studied the programmatic material of Slovak politicians and attended online lectures and workshops of the teaching and academic staff of the faculty.
