Europe Unlocked: Connecting Young Leaders

Seminar | 10/02/2025–14/02/2025 | in Rzeszów, Poland

Main activities: The seminar focused on fostering collaboration and creativity among young leaders through interactive workshops, thought-provoking discussions, and motivational talks.
