LEARNING CONTEXT

Youth Exchanges supported by the Erasmus+ programme offer groups of young people from different countries an opportunity to jointly design, prepare and carry out a non-formal learning programme on a topic of their interest. This usually involves a mix of workshops, debates, role-plays, simulations and outdoor activities. The learning process, which is supported by youth workers and leaders, includes the preparation, implementation and follow-up of the exchange.

COMPETENCES DEVELOPED BY YULIANA RUBISH

The following summary is the result of a reflection and self-assessment process which took place during and after the project.

Multilingual competence

From February 24 to 28, the city of Rzeszów, Poland, hosted a youth exchange under the Erasmus+ program focused on photography. Participants from different countries came together to explore the art of photography, learn new techniques, and share their experiences. The program included workshops on composition basics, lighting techniques, and photo editing. Participants also had the opportunity to practice their skills during city photo walks, capturing Rzeszów's architecture, nature, and daily life. Beyond the educational sessions, the project promoted intercultural exchange young people discovered Polish culture, communicated, and collaborated in international teams.

Personal, social and learning to learn competence

This project helped me develop important skills such as self-confidence, communication with other participants, and teamwork. Through group discussions and collaborative tasks, I learned to express my thoughts more clearly and find common ground with people from different countries.

Citizenship competence

We not only learned about photography but also discussed important social issues such as environmental protection and gender equality. This made me think more deeply about these topics and express my views through art. Working on these themes helped me realize that even photography can be a powerful way to convey important messages to society.

Entrepreneurship competence

The project organizers created excellent conditions for learning and communication. They managed to bring together people from different countries and provide them with the opportunity not only to improve their photography skills but also to broaden their horizons. Thanks to their professionalism and well-organized approach, this trip became a very valuable experience for me.
