BUP Student Conference 2025

The Student Conference was held between 23-26 April 2025 in Tallinn, Estonia at BUP participating university, Tallinn University. The event welcomed 81 students from all 10 countries included within the BUP and was organised by The BUP Coordinating Secretariat at Uppsala University and Tallinn University. The Learning objectives were:

- Develop students' expertise in interdisciplinary and intercultural communication.
- Introduce and expand students' skills in different academic activities; workshopping, discussions, moderating and presenting.
- Reflect on the role of water in building climate resilience in urban environments, with a focus on cities in the Baltic Sea Region.
- Encourage students to become problem-solving thinkers, with a view to the future and continuing a sustainable future/rebuilding.

The Baltic University Programme (BUP) is one of the largest university co-operations in the world, with about 115 participating universities in the Baltic Sea Region, co-operating for education and research in Sustainable Development and Democracy.

The BUP recommends that the student be given 1.5 ECTS for this training, corresponding to 40 hours of workload.
